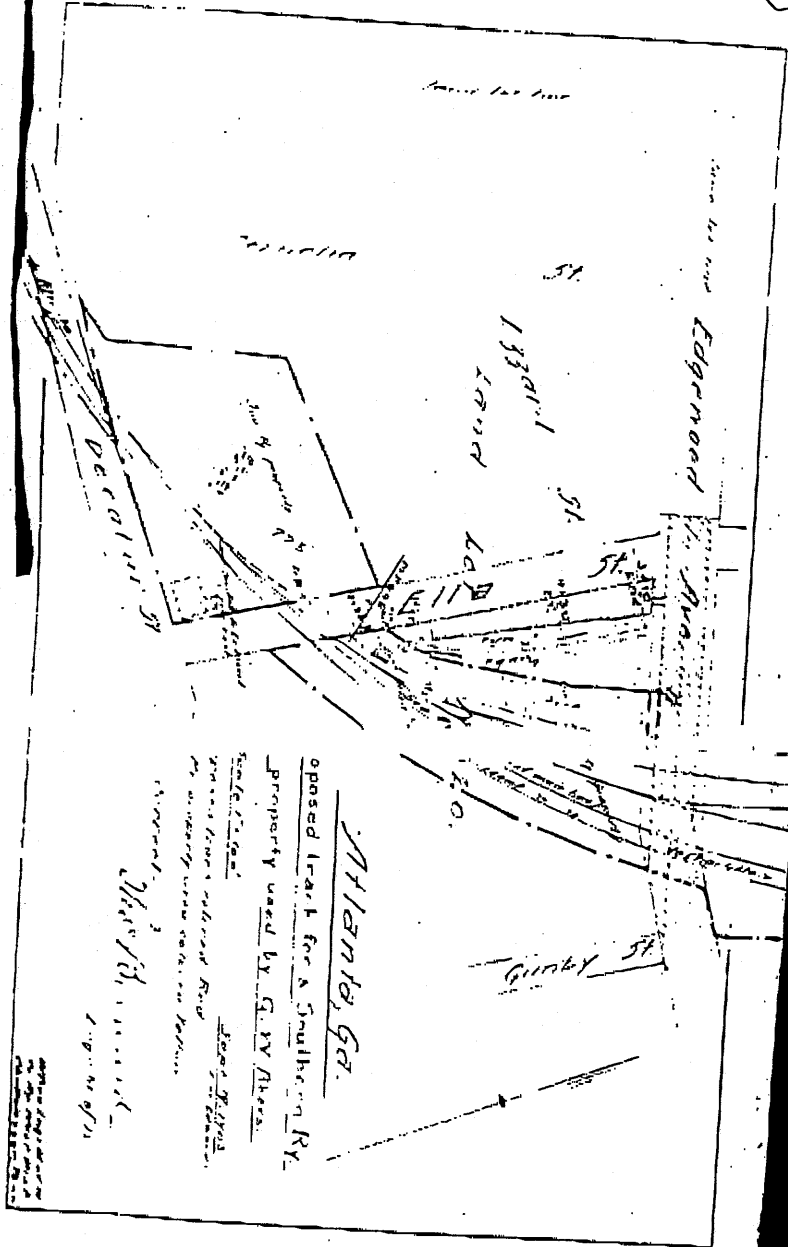

Witnesseth:
 That the party of the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of One Dollar to him or her or his or her
 Railway Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged, has granted bargained and conveyed and conveyed
 and assigns, presents uses new grant, bargain, sell
 and conveys unto the Railway Company
 A Right of way or fourteen (14) feet in width upon the
 lands of the party of the first part, situate lying, and
 being South of Edgewood Avenue between Ella Street
 and the right of way of the Railway Company in the City
 of Atlanta in the County of Fulton and State of Georgia
 for a spur track, which will spring from the cur-
 rent main track of the Railway Company running
 between Atlanta and Roswell 75 feet west of No. 10 post
 No 626, and will extend thence northward by a 16° curve
 E. 430 feet and by a tangent 30 feet, more or less to spring
 near the south side of said Edgewood Avenue, 100
 feet 185 feet will be on the property of the Railway
 Company, which Ella Street 50 feet upon Ella Street
 twenty feet upon the right of way of the Railway Company
 east of Ella Street and 255 feet more or less upon the
 said land of the party of the first part, beginning at the
 dividing line between the land of the party of the first
 part and the right of way of the Railway Company east
 of Ella Street and running thence northwardly follow-
 ing the alignment of said spur track as located,

and being 7 feet in width on either side of the center line thereof as located upon the land of the party of the first part; such as shall be shown upon the blue print map hereto annexed and made a part of this indenture.

So have we to be held, the said right of way into the Railway Company, its successors and assigns, as it or they may acquire the same for the land and operation maintenance and repair of said street, shown as a hatched and this consequence in order upon this condition: That the party of the second part shall have the right and the same is hereby reserved to himself, his heirs and assigns, to lay down, remove or said spur tracks from the premises of his party on the first part at any time after the separation of the land as said land of the party of the first part to the Farmers Exchange a Corporation, the turning upon the Railway Company sixty (60) days after the date of the date of the order and upon the effect of the date the Railway Company shall within a reasonable time not to exceed thirty (30) days and more take up, remove and said track, and all rails, cross ties, posts and fixtures from said road and thereupon the land and rights hereof hereby conveyed to the Railway Company shall revert to the party of the first part, his heirs and assigns.
