said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and power to go in, upon and along the tract of  
land owned by the undersigned in Land Lot 20 of the 14 District, of  
Eliz. T.L.L., County, known as No. 75 Bellville St.,  
is or near the City or Town of Hartwell, Georgia, together with the right  
to construct, operate and maintain upon said land its lines for transmitting electric current, erected one or more lines of  
poles, with wires and other necessary apparatus, fixtures and appliances; with the right to permit the attachment of  
the wires and appliances of any other company, or person, to said poles; together with the right at all times to enter  
upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting and testing, making repairs, renewals, alterations and extensions  
thereon, thereto or therefrom; also the right to cut away or trim and keep clear, of said lines all trees, limbs of  
trees and other obstructions that may interfere or be likely to interfere with the proper operation of said lines; also  
the right of ingress and egress over said land to and from said lines.

The undersigned does not convey any land, but merely grants the hereinbefore described rights, privileges and immunitiess.
