The within and foregoing case coming on regularly to be heard and both parties agreeing hereto, it is by consent considered, ordered and adjudged that the condemnor, COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY, have and recover judgment against the condemnor, COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY, in the amount of \$11,200.00; it further appearing to the Court that the said COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY has heretofore tendered into the Registry of Cobb Superior Court on October 12, 1962 the sum of \$37,000.00, and it further appearing by Order dated November 26, 1962 and consented to by both parties that said sum was deposited at interest in the Marietta Federal Savings & Loan Association, it is considered, ordered and adjudged that the Clerk of this Court withdraw said sum, together with interest thereon, from Marietta Federal Savings & Loan Association and that said Clerk further disburse from such monies in his custody to the said MRS. VELETA LESTER WILSON the sum of ~~\$11,200.00~~ <sup>10,000.00 + 1200.00 to the attorney, O.F. Smith & S.C. Han</sup> and that the remaining money held by the Clerk, to-wit: the said \$25,800.00, plus interest on the entire \$37,000.00 to date, be paid to the condemnor COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY, less the costs of Court in the amount of \$18<sup>00</sup>; all in compliance with Section 36-606<sup>stay</sup> of the Georgia Code.

By further agreement of the parties it is hereby considered, ordered and adjudged that the permanent easement granted to the condemnor, COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY, as described in their Notice of Condemnation shall be reduced from 100 feet in width, as set forth in the condemnation notice and plat attached thereto, to a total of 50 feet in width and being 25 feet on either side of the centerline of the pipe as now laid upon the said property of MRS. VELETA LESTER WILSON, and as shown upon the plat dated July 30, 1962 attached to the said Notice of Condemnation, it being further represented that the said pipe as now laid is in the approximate center of the right-of-way as shown on the said plat herein referred to and dated July 30, 1963.
